When You are Home

• If you are experiencing cramping or backache, take medication per your physician's recommendation.

Bleeding	
 Spotting or light bleeding is normal. If bleeding becomes heavy, or you are concerned, please contact y physician. 	our
Intercourse	
 You can have sexual intercourse after the bleeding stops and you feel comfortable, BUT you MUST real alternative contraception until after your 3 month visit. 	main on
 Please call your physician if your period is more than five days late. 	
<u>In 3 Months</u>	
 You will need to visit your physician 3 months after your Essure procedure to have an evaluation included a hysterosalpingogram (HSG). The evaluation is performed to make sure that both of your Essure inserts are in the correct position and that both of your tubes have been blocked. 	
 You MUST use another form of contraception, other than an IUD, until you have this test and your phy you that you can rely on Essure for contraception. 	/sician tells
• If you rely on Essure for contraception before completing this evaluation, you may get pregnant, ectopic pregnancy (pregnancy outside your uterus, but inside the body). Ectopic pregnancies can threatening.
